

POLICIES OF THE LONDON SENIOR GAMES (LSG)

Policy 100-1

REPLACEMENT

The London Senior Games Committee wishing to establish a sense of fairness to all involved establishes the following policy regarding the replacement of participants who may qualify for competition beyond the London area

SINGLE/PAIR Events

1.0 Winners of the GOLD MEDAL in any or all events will automatically qualify for the next level of competition.

2.0 Should the GOLD medal winner(s) be unable to participate due to:

- a) illness
- b) unavailability
- c) participation in another event
- d) any reason

the SILVER medal winner(s) will be offered the opportunity to compete.

3.0 Should #1 or #2 be unable to participate, the BRONZE medal winner(s) shall be offered the chance to compete. This opportunity will continue through #4, #5, #6 and so forth until a replacement is found.

TEAM EVENTS (3 or more participants in a single event)

4.0 In the case where a replacement of a TEAM consisting of 3 or more persons, the following procedure should be followed:

- a) the remaining members of the GOLD MEDAL Team shall select a replacement from the competitors participating in the event. This person may or may not be from a medal winning team.
- b) Where winning teams of gold, silver and bronze medals are unable to participate, individuals on these teams will be encouraged to combine (gold and silver participants first) in order to form a competitive team
- c) Where possible replacements competitor should be of equal ability to the person she/he is replacing.

5.0 This policy will be administered by the District Co-ordinator or their designate.
